They would put the THING USED in the _____ case and use _____ preposition.

ex: Julius sell _____ vehitur. (Cap. VI, Line 78)

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A way to remember HOW to form these sneaky phrases!

“**from**” - ABlative use the endings -ō or -ā

ex: from Rome = Romā

“**to**” - ADcusative use the endings um or am

ex: to Rome = Romam

“**in**” - gINitive use the endings ī or ae

ex: in Rome = Romae

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
