

Notes for Latin Summer Review in preparation for Latin II

Students should review the following and make sure to master the material before starting Latin II in the fall.

- I. Review the five noun declensions, and adjectives (1st, 2nd, and 3rd declensions and comparative and superlative)
- II. Review Pronouns
- III. Review Adverbs (including comparative and superlative)
- IV. Complete Chapters I – XVIII Review Test Satisfactorily
- V. Verbs - please be sure to master your knowledge of the following:
 - a. Identify the four conjugations.
 - b. Identify irregular and deponent verbs.
 - c. Be able to conjugate all four conjugations in the six tenses – active and passive.
 - i. Present
 - ii. Imperfect
 - iii. Future
 - iv. Perfect
 - v. Pluperfect
 - vi. Future Perfect
 - d. Be able to identify the Tense, Voice, Mood, Person, and Number (These Verbs Make People Nutty) of any verb.
 - e. Compose/identify/translate the Imperatives for each verb.
 - f. Compose/identify/translate all six active and passive Infinitives.
 - g. Compose/identify/translate all three Participles and be able to decline to match the noun each modifies.
 - h. Compose/identify/translate Supines.
- VI. Complete synopses on a regular basis throughout the summer using the Chapters 21-24 infinitives list.

- VII. Master/Review the Chapters 21-24 Infinitives list.
- VIII. Translate various sections of Chapters 17 through 24 focusing on the last four chapters.
- IX. Review vocabulary and objectives from chapters 17-24.
