- equal sign between two words or expressions that have the same or virtually the same meaning (ex. evil = bad)
- **O:** "that is to say" and is used to explain the meaning of a word in a particular context (ex. she **O**: Julia)
- \leftrightarrow "is the opposite of" (ex. good \leftrightarrow bad)
- "comes from" or "is derived from" and is used to show the origin of words that are derived from other words which you already know (ex. sunny < sun)</p>
